## Sermon Notes The Temptations of Jesus: When The Bible Is Bait Matthew 4:1-11

Have you ever had someone quote you... but not really quote you? They snatch one thing you said, rip it out of context, and suddenly you're the villain.

We must never divorce one portion of scripture from another. Here is the first truth that we must learn from Jesus' temptation, the pitfall of...

- **1. The Text** (Matt. 4:6)
  - We must always compare things with spiritual. (1Cor. 2:13)
  - The devil is still twisting scripture today!

#### When we twist the text to suit ourselves, we stop trusting the Author.

- 2. The Lord (Matt. 4:7)
  - God is not to be tested. • (Heb. 3:9-11)
  - Rather than trust God's power and promise, Israel grumbled. They blamed Moses. They even talked about appointing a new leader to take them back to Egypt. (Num. 14:22-23, 29)

- The Father 3.
  - God is to be trusted, not the spectacular. (Jn. 2:23-25, 6:26-29)
  - We are to have faith and trust in Him when nothing looks spectacular. No signs, no blessings, no obvious provision — just trust in God's unchanging character. (Hab. 3:17-18)
  - Jesus knew He had **no reason to test** the Father because He trusted the Father. It's no wonder, therefore, that His message to us repeatedly in the book of Matthew is, "Don't worry." (Mat. 6:26-30)

If God cares for plants and animals. He will surely provide for His children.

(Lk. 11:13)

There are three **non-negotiables** if we're going to win this kind of temptation:

- We must walk with God moment by moment.
- We must live in His Word deeply and rightly.
- We must remember that Satan's power is limited.

And here's the beautiful thing: in time, Jesus did receive all that Satan offered but not by compromise. By obedience.
