Check Your Heart | Isaiah 3:8-12

1. The Heart is the Core Vital

	The heart is the core of physically and spiritually.
	[Proverbs 4:23] "Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it."
	A. God Knows the Heart [1 Sam. 16:7] "the LORD looketh on the heart."
	See also [Psalm 139:1–4, Proverbs 21:2, Jeremiah 17:10]
	God sees our, intentions, and motives.
2.	The Heart Reveals True Spiritual Health
	What's in the heart eventually shows up in the [Lk. 6:45]
	Isaiah points to two clear symptoms:
	A. Words "Their tongues are against the" (v.8)
	If you want to know the condition of your spiritual heart, listen to your words that come out o your mouth Monday – Saturday.
	What comes out your is evidence of the Spirit's work. [Pro. 15:4, Ja. 1:26, 3:2, 8]
	B. Actions "Their doings are against the" (v.8)
	A pattern of open great indicator of spiritual heart disease. (v.9)
	[Is 5:20] "Woe to those who call evil and good"
	Moral decline is not, it's a precursor to its demise.
3.	The Cure for a Sick Heart [Is 3:10]
	A. Repentance Key Takeaway: The spiritual heart
	Acknowledging and turning from sin to God. determines the flow of life. Guard it, diagnose it, and let God transform it.
	B. Faith in God's Provision
	Righteousness is through faith in Christ.
	[Rom. 4:23–25] God deposits His into your account.
	God doesn't do bypass, He does heart [Ez. 36:26]
